

**Project 1 Alpha Prototype: Snack Chips**

San Jose State University - School of Information

### Statement of Purpose:

The combination of a sandwich and chips is a common meal offered at many deli and sub shops. Snack-sized chips are a popular grab-and-go food for customers looking for a quick pairing to complete their meal. One can also easily find the snack-sized goodies for sale at their local convenience store as an individual treat.

In addition, there are food aficionados who are deeply invested in finding a good bag of chips to go with their sandwiches. Deli enthusiasts have chosen some combinations as their top preference: bacon, lettuce, and tomato (BLT) with Flamin' Hot Cheetos, or a French Dip with Hawaiian Sweet Maui Onion Rings (Thompson, 2019).

Flamin' Hot Cheetos are a common option for those looking for a spicy and crunchy snack. There is an intentional design element that goes into the creation of snack foods. Flamin' Hot Cheetos uses cheese, Monosodium Glutamate (MSG), and food coloring, for example, in order to make their product more appealing. This is partially so that they do not resemble "whitish worms," as this is "not a look that signals hot and cheesy to your brain," according to Tonn (2016).

Not all patrons of a sandwich shop, however, would be interested in purchasing Flamin' Hot Cheetos. Consumers have distinct preferences in texture, flavor, and degree of spiciness. These characteristics are therefore fundamentally important for the query, and are thus reflected in the data structure. The data structure includes all possible flavors of the snack-sized chips, based on their respective ingredients.

Sometimes, the flavor and ingredient combinations can be unexpected. One would not have anticipated cheese to appear in the ingredients for barbecue-flavored chips, for example (Lay's, n.d.). The snacks therefore have a wide option of flavor profiles, ranging from sweet and

spicy to more exotic flavors, such as smoky. The database is indicative of the wide range of flavor combinations potentially presented in each snack, and can easily be expanded for future product additions.

Our database objective is to find the appropriate chips to satisfy the customer base of snack-sized chips. A sandwich shop owner would need to appeal to 18-34 year olds in particular, as they are in the age range when they are most receptive to trying new flavors, and tend to use the chips as a “gateway snack,” (Frito-Lay, n.d). For example, Firehouse Subs’ website has a category simply labeled, “Chips,” and names the brands that they carry in-store. Some of these brands include: Miss Vickie's, SunChips, Lay's, Baked Lay's and Ruffles (Firehouse Subs, n.d.).

Ultimately, there will be differing trends based on consumer whim, as well as what the user (in this case, a sandwich shop owner) requires in order to do business. For this reason, brand names are highly important for the database user. Buying in bulk for resale can often be easier when searching for a large name brand, and searches from the user would reveal their preference in name brands for their business. Finally, this gives the sandwich shop patrons peace of mind, as the chip bag is familiar, yet exciting new flavors potentially await.

## Rules

**Field Name:** Product Name

**Form Type:** Text

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** This field identifies the name given to the chip product by the manufacturer.

**Rule:** Enter the product name found on the product page of the manufacturer's website, including any accent marks and punctuation marks. Do not include trademark symbols. Capitalize product name using title case capitalization. Do not include manufacturer name or descriptive text found on packaging.

Product Name Examples: "Ruffles Queso Cheese", "Lay's Sweet Southern Heat BBQ", "Cheetos Crunchy Flamin' Hot", "Chester's Flamin' Hot Fries", "Cheetos Crunchy Cheddar Jalapeño".

**Field Name:** Manufacturer

**Form Type:** Text

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** This field identifies the name of the manufacturer or subsidiary that manufactures, markets, and sells the chip product.

**Rule:** Enter the full manufacturer name, including abbreviations for different kinds of business entities (LLC, Inc., and Corp.). Manufacturer name is found on the back of the product package, printed underneath the list of ingredients. Include any accent marks or punctuation marks. Do not include trademark symbols or copyright year. Capitalize manufacturer name using title case capitalization.

Manufacturer Name Examples: Frito Lay, Inc.

**Field Name:** Starch Type

**Form Type:** List

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** This field identifies the starch ingredients in the chip product. This may include cereals (rice, wheat, and corn) and root vegetables (potatoes and cassava).

**Rule:** Determine the starch ingredients in the chip product based on the product ingredient list. Ingredient list is found on the back of the product package. Select all starch types from the list that are applicable. Starch ingredients may include cereals (rice, wheat, and corn) and root vegetables (potatoes and cassava). If the ingredient list says, "(Enriched) Corn Meal" or "Corn Flour", select "Corn". If the ingredient list says, "Potatoes", "Potato Flour", "Potato Starch", or "Dried Potatoes", select "Potato". If starch type is not found within the list, select "Other". If the starch type is unknown and cannot be determined, select "Unknown".

**Field Name:** Spicy

**Form Type:** Yes or No

**Dropdown Required:** No

**Definition:** This field identifies whether the chip product is spicy or not, as stated by the manufacturer.

**Rule:** Determine if the chip flavor is spicy based on the manufacturer's product description on the product package or product page of the manufacturer's website. Descriptive language may include "Spicy", "Heat", or "Hot". If the manufacturer clearly indicates on the product package or product page of the manufacturer's website that the product is spicy, check the box. If there is no indication on the product package or product page of the manufacturer's website that the product is spicy, leave the box unchecked. If unknown and cannot be determined, leave the box unchecked.

**Field Name:** Baked

**Form Type:** Yes or No

**Dropdown Required:** No

**Definition:** This field identifies whether the chip product is baked or not, as stated by the manufacturer.

**Rule:** If the manufacturer clearly indicates on the product package or product page of the manufacturer's website that the product is baked, check the box. If there is no indication on the product package or product page of the manufacturer's website that the product is baked, leave the box unchecked.

**Field Name:** Texture

**Form Type:** List

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** This field identifies the overall texture and/or mouthfeel of the product(s).

**Rule:** The current options available are: crunchy, wavy, smooth, airy, and other. Use product packaging descriptions as an aid. When texture is not clearly defined by packaging or website description, choose "Other".

**Field Name:** Flavor

**Form Type:** List

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** This field indicates the overall taste and flavor profile of the product, as stated by product packaging.

**Rule:** Use the approximate overarching flavor as spelled and described on the packaging and in the database. For flavors that contain cheese, select "Cheesy". For flavors that contain BBQ seasoning, select "Smoky". For flavors that contain spices or vinegar flavor, (examples: "Flamin' Hot" or "Salt and Vinegar"), select "Vinegary". You can also find this information on the manufacturer's website (such as Frito-Lay). Compare these options to the options available in the database, and select the categories as stated above. It is acceptable to use multiple categories. If this information is not available for use, or there is no additional flavoring added, choose "other".

**Field Name:** Price

**Form Type:** List

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** The market value of the manufactured product.

**Rule:** List all prices in USD format, for example: "\$5.65". Since prices fluctuate within geographic areas, place each price in the following general categories: "Under \$4", "\$4 to \$8", "\$8 and up". If looking for more specific prices, use a major retailer (such as Walmart) in order to discern appropriate costs.

**Field Name:** Size (oz.)

**Form Type:** List

**Dropdown Required:** Yes

**Definition:** The package size as listed by weight (in ounces).

**Rule:** List weight in ounces, using the exact figure provided on manufacturer's packaging. If another measurement is provided, convert this unit to ounces, using whole numbers and fractions where applicable. Example: "3 and  $\frac{5}{8}$  oz" as opposed to a measurement in grams (g). There are currently three size ranges available: "Under 4 oz", "4 to 8 oz", "Over 8 oz".
